- *Kings-Chron – passing from Elijah to Elisha and empowering the craftsmen of the temple*
- *Prophets – promised through the _____ (Is 61) and in the New Covenant (Jer 31)*

What is the Holy Spirit's mission?

- **REVEAL:** Represent God in and through us
 - The Holy Spirit _____ God by transforming our minds to **UNDERSTAND** God and giving **LIFE** to our bodies to live like Jesus (Rom 8:5,11)
- **RELATE:** Comfort, counsel, and convict us
 - Our _____ with the Holy Spirit (Romans 8:14-17)
 - We received the Spirit who now **LIVES** in us
 - He **ADOPTS** us as God's children
 - He makes us **CO-HEIRS** with Jesus as brothers/sisters!
- **RESCUE:** Empower, embolden, and encourage us
 - He _____ the brokenhearted, captives, and prisoners and fills us to make us **RESCUERS!** (Luke 4:18-19)
